Art Students Win Bean Prize for Study in Rome

Emily Greenberg (B.F.A. '13), Michael Picos (B.F.A. '13), and Anne Wu (B.F.A. '13) were selected as the 2011–12 recipients of the David R. Bean Prize in Fine Arts. The three undergraduate art students studied with the Cornell in Rome program during the spring 2012 semester.

The prize was established in memory of David Richard Bean '71 by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Albert Bean '43. David graduated from Cornell with a degree in government administration. While a student, he

spent time in Europe and was enchanted with Florence, and had planned to study art. The annual prize provides financial support for travel in Europe, and each prize recipient is given a copy of Bean's writings and artwork.
